

- 1- The Project coordinator opens the meeting asking on the host school name if

the partners need anything for the Project Logo Competition of the next day, such as printing the logos or for the Theatre Performance on Wednesday such as checking the computers, music, decorations etc. the Italian school will need a piano, the Spanish school needs music for the performance and for the school presentation all the schools need computers,

- 2- The Project coordinator asks the partners if the project has arisen problems at the partners' school. All the partners agree the project has had a very good welcome at the schools, students and teachers have shown interest in taking part in it and all the partners agree the lack of time has been the main difficulty arisen. To match lessons at school plus family plus work for the project is sometimes difficult to handle.
- 3- All the participants agree they are following the steps marked in the Project brochure. They add they have spent the term preparing the initial activities for the project and the activities designed for the first mobility of the Project. The are also doing extra activities based on oral communication such as theatre, dialogues or sketches at the schools with the students to encourage communication, for example some schools are preparing Christmas Theatre in English.
- 4- The school in the Project did, first of all, the initial survey about the interest of students for foreign Languages.

The second activity was done at each partner's place. It consisted of an interview students did to a relevant personality of each school's community.

The third activity was to prepare an oral school presentation to present in Poland. Students focused on the description of the region, school and activities doe in it.

The fourth activity was to tell the students to prepare a collage they used to introduce themselves in a workshop in Poland.

The fifth activity was different at each school as it was the play or play they had selected to present at the Christmas Festival in Poland.

5- Then it was the time to discuss the activities to be done in the Mobility in Lithuania. The topic for this mobility was debates. Teachers discussed about the possible topics: Music, History, Art, Youth Problems etc.

Finally it was decided the teachers will comment the students different options to see what the want to talk about. Each school will present an individual debate and the will do two debates together.

Students will also prepare a presentation of their region and school as it is a very interesting activity for dissemination at the visitors' place.

The Lithuanian school also wants to prepare a "Traditional Music Festival" and wants the

partners to prepare a Traditional Dance of their places.

6- After some consideration it is decided that the dates for the Second Mobility in Pajuris,

Lithuania will be May. It seems to be a good date because there is time enough to prepare

the activities and the weather is supposed to be good.

7- The next point of the Work Session was to talk about the eGuide. The schools had done

the preliminary survey and the results had been contrasted via email and were already

reflected in the guide. Each school had previously presented the methodology they use

currently with Foreign Languages and it is already reflected in the guide.

8- The final point of the session is to talk about the dissemination activities schools are doing

and the impact they are arising.

The project is constantly being disseminated online via the Web Page, the Blog, Facebook

and eTwinning. Besides schools send press reports, TV, visits to the local Radio Station,

exhibits students works at school.

All the shool communities are interested in the project and it is working well.

The next step will be to contrast these different methodologies and to suggest an "ideal"

one.


